

**Methodology:**

The age of the active cases and adjourned sine die cases that are pending before the court, measured as the number of days from filing until the time of measurement.

The cases that have been monitored are only civil matters from all level of court:-

1. High Court Civil Suit (HCCS)
2. Intermediate Court Civil Suit (ICCS)
3. Magistrate Court Civil Suit (MCCS)
4. Bankruptcy
  - a. Creditors Petition (CP)
  - b. Debtors Petition (DP)
  - c. Involuntary Company Winding Up (ICWP)

This measurement will show that the higher the percentage of ageing list (Active cases and Adjourned Sine Die cases), the more pending caseload the court has.

Ageing list is calculated:

<p><b><i>Active Cases</i></b></p> $\frac{\text{Active cases over 24 months}}{\text{Total Active cases}} \times 100\%$	<p><b><i>Adjourned Sine Die Cases</i></b></p> $\frac{\text{Adjourned Sine Die cases over 24 months}}{\text{Total Adjourned Sine Die cases}} \times 100\%$
